Ingredients

Ground soybean hulls, ground oats, dried beet pulp, dehulled soybean meal, cane molasses, ground aspen, ground oat hulls, brewers dried yeast, soybean oil, salt, lignin sulfonate, flaxseed, dicalcium phosphate, monocalcium phosphate, calcium propionate, sodium sesquicarbonate, artificial flavor, magnesium oxide, calcium carbonate, sucrose, d-alpha tocopheryl acetate (natural source vitamin E), tocopherols (a preservative), riboflavin, biotin, cholecalciferol (vitamin D₃), calcium pantothenate, vitamin A acetate, thiamin mononitrate, nicotinic acid, vitamin B₁₂ supplement, choline chloride, ferrous sulfate, potassium iodide, manganous oxide, cobalt carbonate, sodium molybdate, manganese sulfate, zinc oxide, sodium selenite.

Feeding Directions

Feed as a supplement to the normal maintenance diet for ruminants such as sheep kept in restricted circumstances. Feed ad libitum in addition to access to normal roughage diets. Suitable for trough feeding. Always provide animals access to plenty of fresh, clean water.
