New World Primates (e.g., marmosets, tamarins, capuchins, howler monkeys, squirrel monkeys, spider monkeys)	All	New World Primate (5MA5)	Biscuit with Dentaguard™	Feed at least 40% New World Primate to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	All	Leaf-Eater (5M02) or Mini-Biscuit (5672)	Biscuit with higher fiber	Feed at least 40% Leaf-Eater to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	All	Primate Browse (5MA4)	Biscuit with higher fiber and Dentaguard™***	Feed at least 40% Browse Biscuit to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	Growth and Reproduction	Primate Growth & Repro (5MA1)	Biscuit with Dentaguard™	Feed at least 40% Growth and Repro to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	Maintenance	Primate Maintenance (5MA2)	Biscuit with Dentaguard™	Feed at least 40% Maintenance Biscuit to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	All	Callitrichid Diabetic Gel (592Y)	Gel powder with low sugar	Mix Callitrichid Gel with hot water to achieve desired consistency. Feed at least 50% Callitrichid Gel to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	All	Callitrichid High Fiber Gel (5MI6)	Gel powder with higher fiber	Mix Callitrichid Gel with hot water to achieve desired consistency. Feed at least 50% Callitrichid Gel to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
All	Callitrichid High Fiber - Hot Weather Gel (57R0)	Gel powder with higher fiber and heat stability	Mix Callitrichid Gel with hot water to achieve desired consistency. Feed at least 50% Callitrichid Gel to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.	
Geriatric or animals needing higher fiber	Geriatric Gel (5S2R)	Gel powder with highest fiber	Mix Geriatric Gel with hot water to achieve desired consistency. Feed at least 50% Callitrichid Gel to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.

Old World Primates (e.g., gorillas, chimpanzee, macaques, baboons, bonobo, langurs)	All	Primate Basix (5NAA)	Biscuit	Feed at least 40% Primate Basix to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	All	Leaf-Eater Mini-Biscuit (5672)	Biscuit with higher fiber	Feed at least 40% Leaf-Eater to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	All	Primate Browse (5MA4)	Biscuit with higher fiber and Dentaguard™***	Feed at least 40% Browse Biscuit to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	Growth and Reproduction	Primate Growth & Repro (5MA1)	Biscuit with Dentaguard™	Feed at least 40% Growth and Repro to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
	Maintenance	Primate Maintenance (5MA2)	Biscuit with Dentaguard™	Feed at least 40% Maintenance Biscuit to meet Nutrient Recommendations**, plus desired supplementation.
Supplement & Enrichment	All	Enrich Bits (5ZG7)	Small biscuit with added fiber	Scatter Enrich Bits to promote natural foraging behaviors. Enrich Bits will meet Nutrient Recommendations**, if fed at > 40% of the diet.
	All	Monkey Crunch 20 (5M29)	Medium biscuit	Scatter Monkey Crunch to promote natural foraging behaviors. Monkey Crunch will meet Nutrient Recommendations**, if fed at > 40% of the diet.
	All	Primate High Fiber Sticks (5MA3)	Small biscuit	Provide High Fiber Sticks as a supplemental food item or as a part of the complete diet. High Fiber Sticks will meet Nutrient Recommendations**, if fed at greater than 40% of the diet.
	Growing, reproducing, or additional needs	Vita-Zu Primate Tablet (5072)	Vitamin and mineral tablet	Feed with meals. Provide 1/2 tablet to animals < 20 kg; 1 tablet for animals frm 20-70 kg; additional tablets for larger animals
	All	Marmoset Jelly (5041)	Powder with high protein and energy	Miz Marmoset Jelly with ht water to achieve desired consistency. Feed no more than 25% of the diet as Marmoset Jelly.
	All	Jungle Jel (5MF1)	Powder for medication or treats	Mix Jungle Jel with hot water to achieve desired consistency. Supplemental items may be added to the mixture as it is cooling. Feed no more than 10% of the diet as Jungle Jel is not a complete diet.
